DISCUSSION NOTES	Principal report notes from Mrs. Cota read by Mr. Quam Arizona Department of Education (ADE) and Title 1 have eliminated the comprehensive needs assessment for school academic evaluation. There will be no “fishbone” diagram process to be used to determine the root cause analysis. ADE and Title 1 will still have the integrated action plan as a tool to evaluate school needs assessment.
